Vehicular movement - Themes 1&2 (see board 07)

Vehicle access will be via either the improved existing East Gate entrance, off Coldharbour Lane, or the new North Gate entrance, off the Ring Road. Vehicle routes have been designed to make the heart of the Campus virtually traffic free with main car parks located around the edges of the site.
